

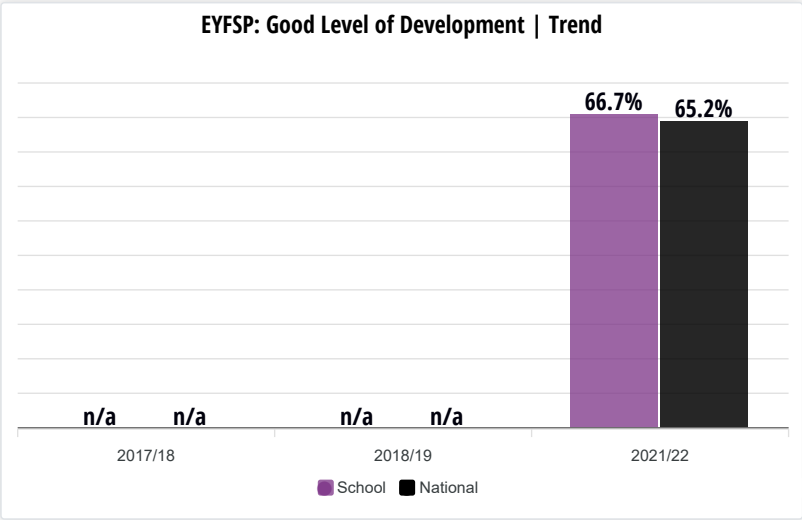
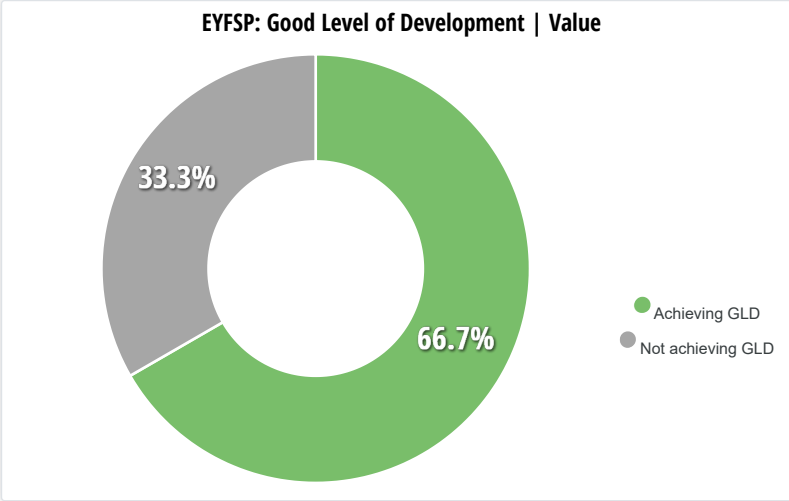

The average total points score, for your school, in all GLD goals is **21.8** out of a possible 24.

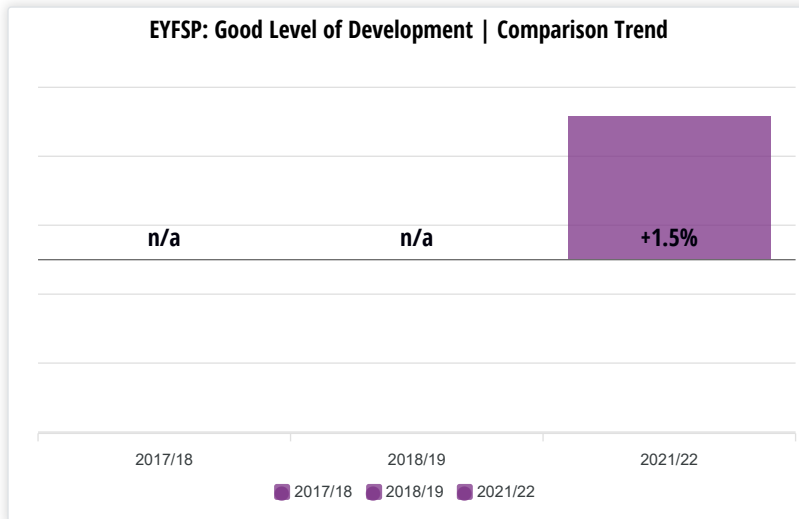
