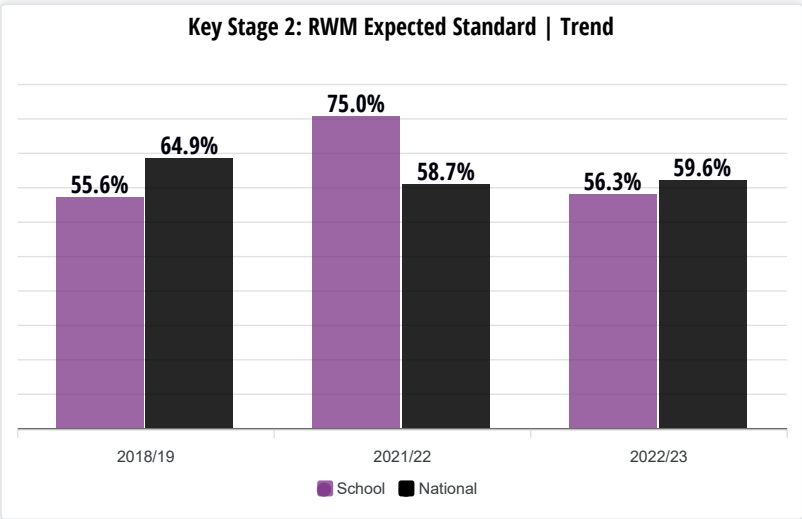
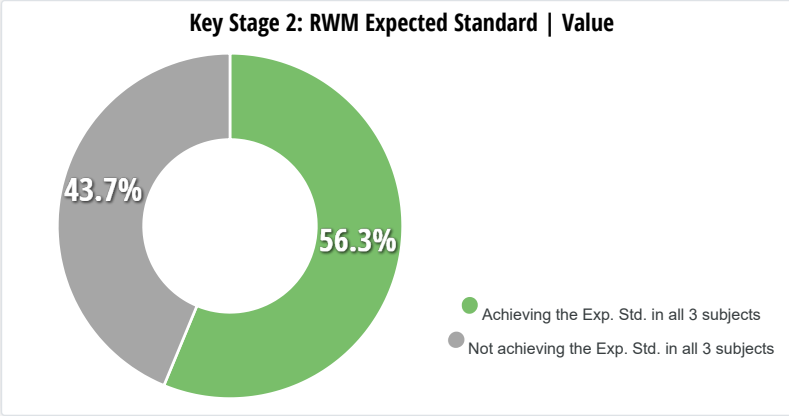

From a cohort of **16 pupils** in your school at the end of Key Stage 2, **56.3%** achieved the expected standard in Reading, Writing & Maths, a total of **9 pupils**.

**31.3%** achieved a scaled score < 100 in Reading, Writing & Maths in your school, a total of **5 pupils**.

**6.3%** achieved a higher standard in Reading, Writing & Maths, with a scaled score equal to or greater than 110, or equivalent TA result, a total of **1 pupil**.



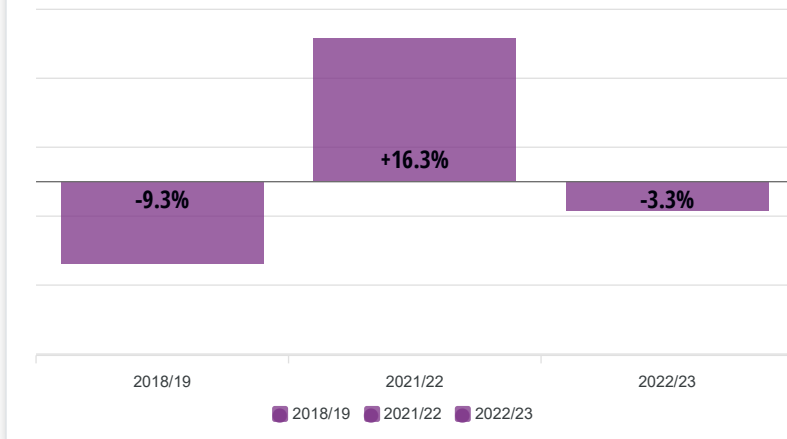
Your school's expected standard percentage in Reading, Writing & Maths has **decreased by 18.7%** from **75.0%** in 2021/22 to **56.3%** in 2022/23.

This is equivalent to approximately **3 fewer** pupils achieving the expected standard in 2022/23 compared to 2021/22.

Your school's average for the last 3 academic year(s) is **60.6%**.

## COMPARISON | NATIONAL

Key Stage 2: RWM Expected Standard | Comparison Trend



**56.3%** achieved the expected standard in Reading, Writing & Maths in your school, **3.3% lower than** the National average of **59.6%**.

This is equivalent to **1 fewer** pupil in your school achieving the expected standard compared to the National average.

Your school has been above the National average **1 time** in the last 3 academic year(s) for the expected standard in Reading, Writing & Maths.

Your school's relative change for expected standard in Reading, Writing & Maths has **declined by 45.2%**, from **+25.6%** in 2021/22 to **-19.6%** in 2022/23 when compared to the National average.

While your school average for expected standard in Reading, Writing & Maths has **decreased by 18.7%**, from **75.0%** in 2021/22 to **56.3%** in 2022/23, the National average **increased by 0.9%**, from **58.7%** in 2021/22 to **59.6%** in 2022/23.

## RANK
