Curriculum Intent for Art:

All believe that we can create our own artwork using inspiration from around the world and our local community.

All achieve a sense of pride when working together or on our own to create artwork.

All create work we are proud of that demonstrates our skills in a range of media and from a range of inspiration.

All a family, sharing our successes, understanding and helping each other to achieve and improve personally; respecting other people's thoughts and accepting contributions even if they are different to our own.

Implementation of Art Curriculum:

- Art is taught using inspiration from different artists and pieces of art from global sources.
- Year skills are split over the course of the two year rolling programme: Year A has a focus on skills of drawing, texture and printing; Year B has a focus on the skills of colour, form and pattern.
- Artist have been chosen as inspiration for classes to use as they examine examples and create their own work.
- Art work and artists link to the class project where this is possible, at other times art work is separate to this.
- Pupils often use drafts to critique their own and the work of others and then to go back and improve, before producing a final piece.
