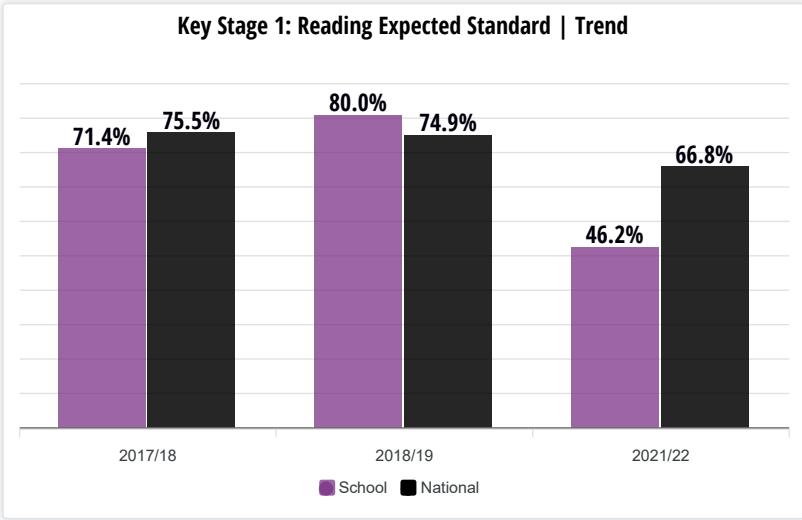

From a cohort of **13 pupils** in your school at the end of Key Stage 1, **46.2%** achieved the expected standard in Reading, a total of **6 pupils**.

**38.5%** achieved a greater depth in Reading, a total of **5 pupils**.



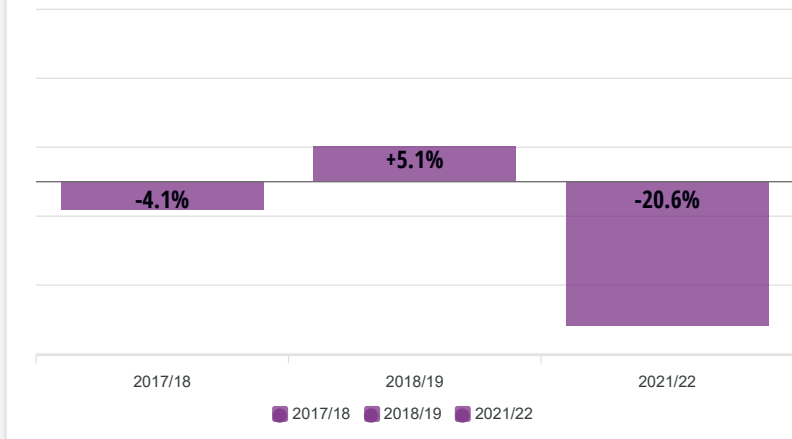
Your school's expected standard percentage in Reading has **decreased by 33.8%** from **80.0%** in 2018/19 to **46.2%** in 2021/22.

This is equivalent to approximately **4 fewer** pupils achieving the expected standard in 2021/22 compared to 2018/19.

Your school's average for the last 3 academic year(s) is **66.7%**.

## COMPARISON | NATIONAL

Key Stage 1: Reading Expected Standard | Comparison Trend



**46.2%** achieved the expected standard in Reading in your school, **20.6% lower than** the National average of **66.8%**.

This is equivalent to **3 fewer** pupils in your school achieving the expected standard compared to the National average.

Your school has been above the National average **1 time** in the last 3 academic year(s) for the expected standard in Reading.

Your school's relative change for expected standard in Reading has **declined by 34.9%**, from **+9.2%** in 2018/19 to **-25.7%** in 2021/22 when compared to the National average.

While your school average for expected standard in Reading has **decreased by 33.8%**, from **80.0%** in 2018/19 to **46.2%** in 2021/22, the National average **decreased by 8.1%**, from **74.9%** in 2018/19 to **66.8%** in 2021/22.
