

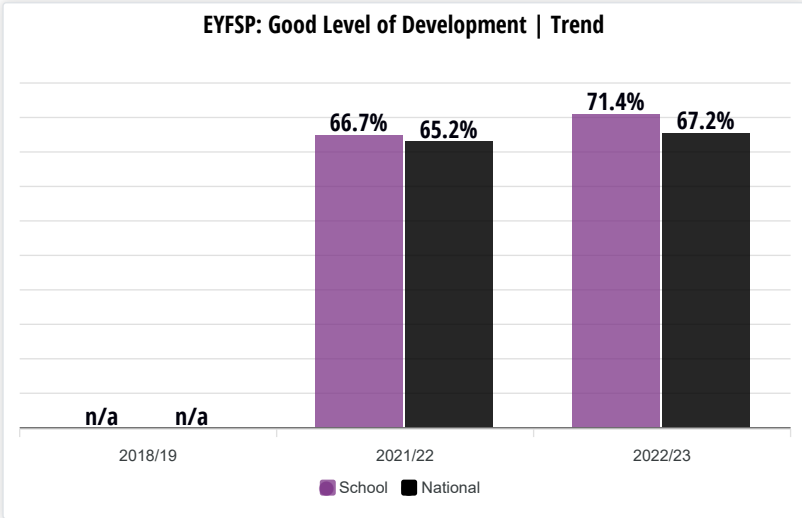
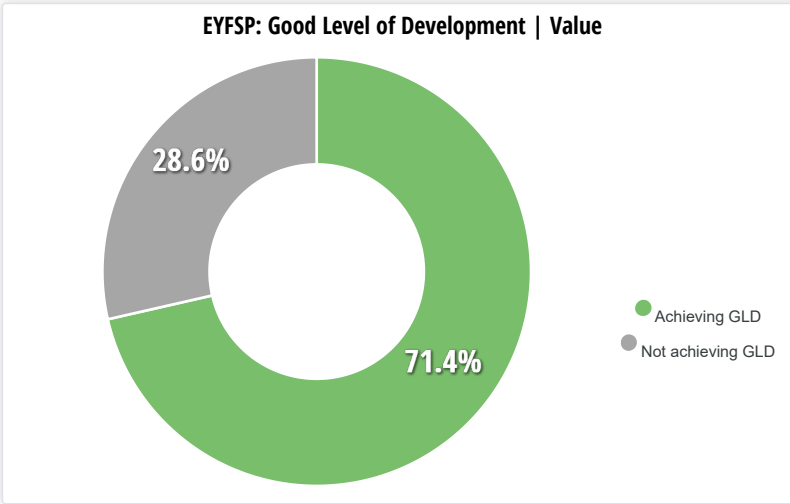

The average total points score, for your school, in all GLD goals is **23.1** out of a possible 24.

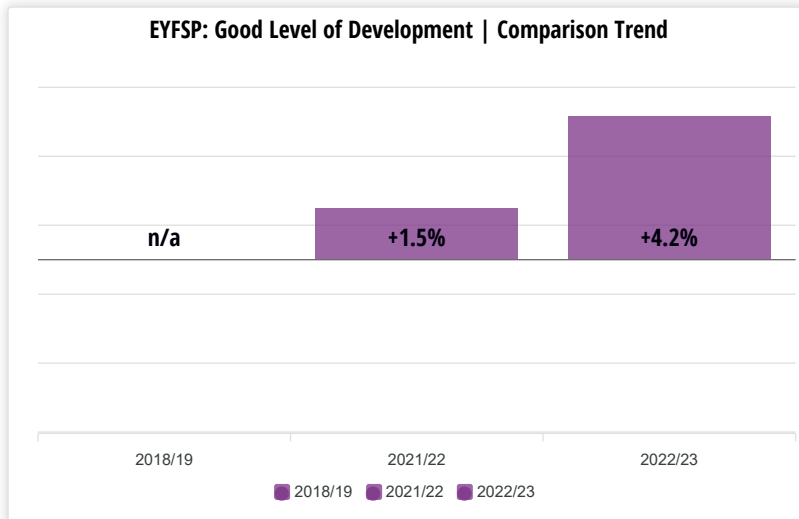


Your school's EYFSP good level of development has **increased by 4.7%** from **66.7%** in 2021/22 to **71.4%** in 2022/23.

This is equivalent to approximately **1 more** pupil achieving a good level of development in 2022/23 compared to 2021/22.

Your school's average for the last 2 academic year(s) is **69.6%**.

## COMPARISON | NATIONAL



**71.4%** achieved a good level of development in your school, **4.2% higher than** the National average of **67.2%**.

This is the equivalent of **1 more** pupil in your school achieving a good level of development compared to the National average.

Your school has been above the National average **2 times** in the last 2 academic year(s).

Your school's relative change for achieving a good level of development has **n/a**, from **n/a** in 2021/22 to **+2.7%** in 2022/23 when compared to the National average.

While your school average for achieving a good level of development has **increased by 4.7%**, from **66.7%** in 2021/22 to **71.4%** in 2022/23, the National average **increased by 2.0%**, from **65.2%** in 2021/22 to **67.2%** in 2022/23.
