



Changes to Class Structure from September

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are writing to share some important information about the structure of our classes from the start of the new academic year.

As you are aware we are continually reviewing how best to serve our children and community. From September, we will be moving from four classes to three. This decision has been made carefully to ensure we continue to provide the best possible education while managing resources effectively.

The new class structure will be:

- Polar Bears (Mrs Curtis): Mixed Reception and Year 1, and Year 2
- White Tigers (Miss MacLachlan): Mixed Years 3 and 4
- Pandas (Mrs Botham): Mixed Years 5 and 6

Mrs Moore and Miss Brown will also be teaching across different year groups as part of this structure.

We are looking forward to welcoming Miss MacLachlan and Mrs Botham back just before the Summer Holiday. Mrs Nicholson and Mrs Stow will both be staying with us until the end of term.

We understand that parents may have questions about how this change will affect the learning experience. Please be reassured that children in Year 1 and Year 2 will continue to receive age-appropriate, focused teaching, and we are planning for Year 1 and Year 2 to be taught away from Reception during key sessions. When this happens, they will be known as the Leopards group.

We are currently working hard to ensure that all children will continue to access a vibrant, engaging, and ambitious curriculum that reflects our school's vision:

Travelling together
Acting in hope

These values guide everything we do, and we are confident that this new structure will help us to continue to deliver exciting opportunities for every child.
