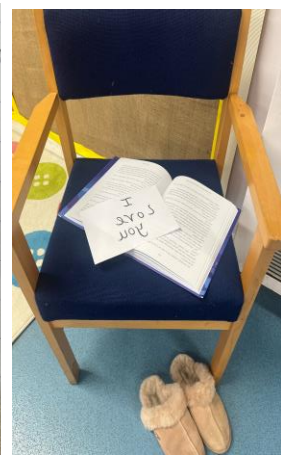
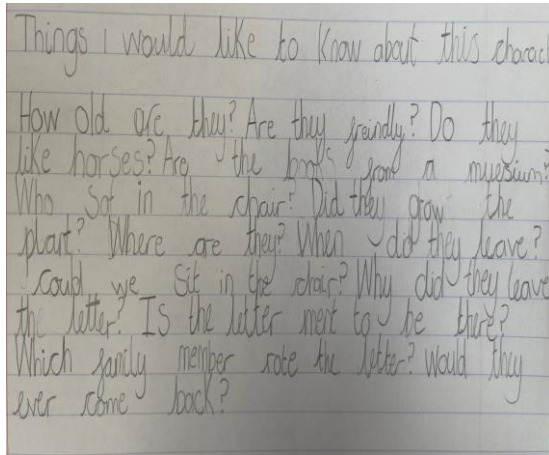

White Tigers: Introduction To a New Book.

White Tigers Class were introduced to a new book this week, *The Heart, and The Bottle* by Oliver Jeffers. They had to guess the scene, ask questions and make predictions about the characters in the book, such as *'How old are they and are they friendly?'*
