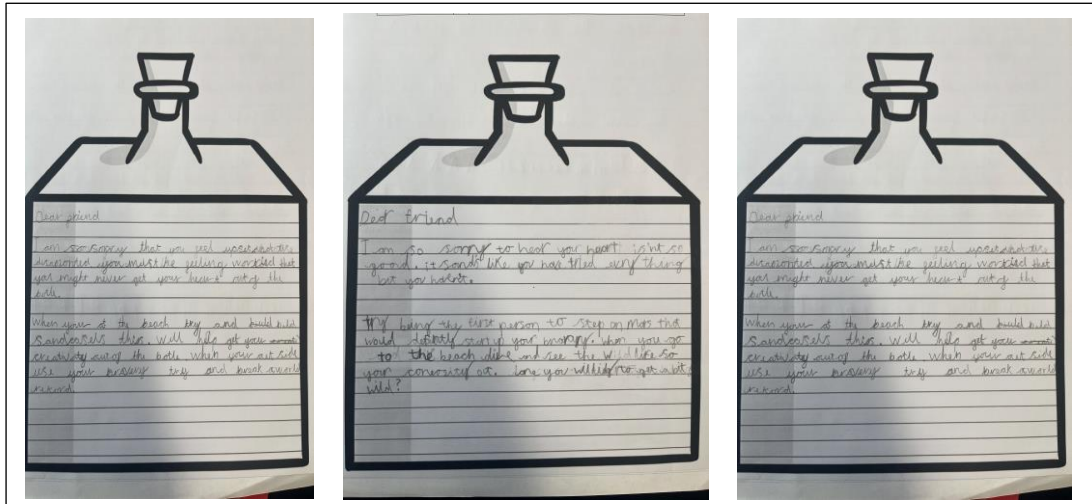

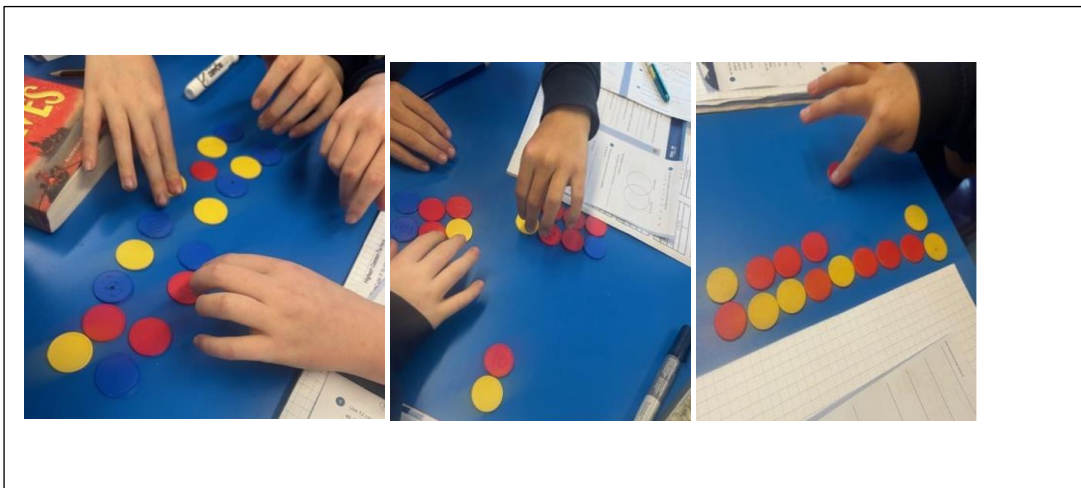
White Tigers: Writing and English.

This week, the children have been writing letters of advice linked to our class writing text 'The heart in the bottle.' They had to write a reply to the lady in the story, offering suggestions as to how she can rescue her heart from the bottle.



Pandas: Maths, Factors.

In Maths this week Pandas have been looking at what a factor is and finding common factors. The children were using counters to make different arrays to show the factors that number held. They started by looking at 18. They found the factors of this number were: 1,2,9 and 18. The children then looked at 20. They found the factors for this number were: 1,2,4,5,10 and 20. We agreed the common factors were 1 and 2 as they were factors in both numbers. We also discussed that 2 is the highest common factor of both numbers.

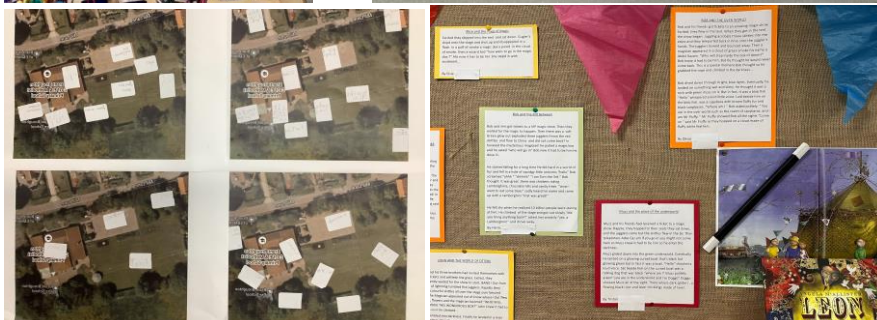
