


## Knowledge Organiser for RE – Pandas (Autumn Term 2020)

Compulsory Unit –Being Human– Islam (What does the Qur’an teach Muslims about how they should treat others? How do Muslim teachings guide the way Muslims act in the world? How are Muslim beliefs expressed in practice? How do beliefs impact on action: expectations of behaviour, ways in which people act, examples of contemporary individuals?)

<p><b>What should we know?</b></p> <p>The importance of the Muslim belief in keeping the world in harmony, as God intended. How shiriah (the straight path) influences everyday life and beliefs, especially in relation to family life and roles. The impact of these beliefs on the actions of Muslims: following the example of the Prophet Muhammad (the Haddith), examples of this in contemporary individuals and also examples of Muslim charities. Understand the beliefs in relation to the Five Pillars of Islam.</p>		<p><b>What should we be able to do?</b></p> <p>Explain the significance of harmony and the shiriah (the straight path) for Muslims. Explain the importance of families with an understanding of traditional Muslim roles. Explain how Muslims demonstrate these beliefs in the way they live.</p> <p><b>End of KS Expectation (Yr 5/6):</b></p> <p>Be able to identify a diverse range of ways in which community impacts on a believer’s experience of a belief tradition. <b>muslim</b>	harmony
<b>shiriah</b>	The straight path
<b>Haddith</b>	Collections of the teachings of the Prophet Muhammad
<b>ummah</b>	Community, brotherhood, including all humans, not just Muslims
<b>shahadah</b>	Reciting the Muslim profession of faith (1 <sup>st</sup> pillar of Islam)
<b>salat</b>	Performing ritual prayers five times a day (2 <sup>nd</sup> pillar of Islam)
<b>zakat</b>	Paying alms (charity) to benefit the poor and needy (3 <sup>rd</sup> pillar of Islam)
<b>sawm</b>	Fasting during Ramadan (4 <sup>th</sup> pillar of Islam)
<b>hajj</b>	Pilgrimage to Mecca
<b>ummah</b>	Worldwide community of Islam
