Celebration Worship

It was lovely to welcome back parents and carers to Celebration Worship this week, thank you to those who were able to join us.

This week, we have had a special focus on writing in Celebration Worship. School participates in a writing assessment system that is used by hundreds of schools across the country. Writing is anonymously assessed by teachers across the country, including our teachers who also contribute to the assessments of pupils in other schools. It is called 'Comparative Judgements'. School receives progress reports and information about how our children compare with others nationally. At the end of each year, all the information is collated and sent to schools. As we have taken part in this system for over a year, progress is now being able to be tracked for all our pupils over a period of more than a year. Using this information, the system has identified our top boy and girl writer in Key Stage One as Arthur and Eabha; and our top boy and girl writer in Key Stage Two as Sol and Emily M. They have also identified the children who have made the most progress from last academic year to this one as: James S, Eabha, Charlie W and Jamelia. We are really proud of all of them. Well done!
